- When Isaiah Met God in Isaiah 6, it was a day of Awe
- When the angles declared to the shepherds that behold in the City of David a Savior was born, it was a day of Awe
- When Yeshua became the Lamb of God and bore all our sins, it was a day of Awe
- When our Redeemer Rose from the Dead, it was a day of Awe
- We all long for and look forward to the Day when our King will make all things good and right every wrong that will surely be a day of Awe

And all the saints cry out, "Lord Jesus Come!" The Spirit and the Bride say Come! Pray That we might see and Experience the Literal Awe of God!

Instead, be filled with the Spirit. 19 Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, 20 always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
